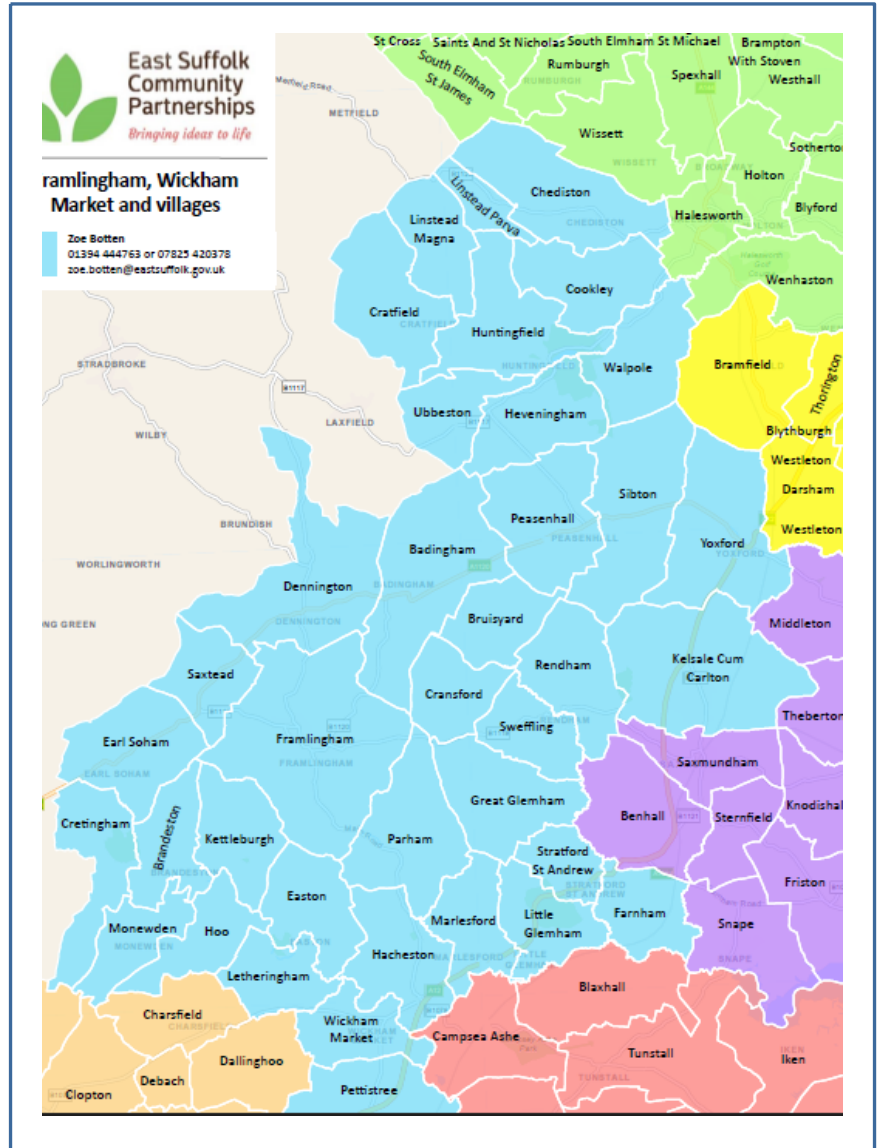
Community Partnership Programme
