Brampton and Stoven village hall	£819.00	They want to organise regular coffee mornings to enable villagers to meet and chat; to check up on the lonely and isolated elderly and vulnerable, and to develop the Village Hall as a hub to signpost people to other services as appropriate
Ditchingham Men's Shed (part funded)	£400.00	They have been gifted a re-conditioned WOODBURNER. The local WOOD STOVE company will install it at minimal cost [£1600].
Fisher Theatre Bungay	£985.00	To deliver weekly online drama workshops to young people aged: 4-8yrs, 9-13yrs and 14-19yrs
BACT Community Transport		Funding would provide transport and a volunteer, who will drive them and introduce them to people on arrival
Falcon Meadow Community Trust Ditchingham, nr Bungay (part funded)	£500.00	Funding to continue the existing surfaced footpath so that it runs the full length of the Meadow, making the riverside walk accessible to all and enabling people to enjoy the constantly changing views of the river and its thriving wildlife throughout the year.
Lowestoft & Waveney Breastfeeding Support	£970.00	Funding to help open more groups to prevent women having to travel to their current home in Lowestoft. To do this they need to train more peer supporters and breastfeeding counsellors
Suffolk Family Carers St Lukes Beccles	£1,000.00	Funding to support their delivery of a young carers club for carers aged 5-11 years
Waveney & Blyth Arts	£1,000.00	Waveney & Blyth Arts (W&BA) has joined up with Halesworth Community Choir to design an intergenerational arts project inspired by nature and involving a wide range of people from the community
