2 Current position

2.1 Licensing Act Premises

On **28 September 2023** there were 1063 Premises Licences and 926 of these include alcohol on the licence.

There were 62 Club Premises Licences.

On **19 December 2023** there were 1064 Premises Licences and 930 of these include alcohol on the licence.

There were 62 Club Premises Licences.

11 new Premises Licences were granted between October and December 2023.

7 Premises Licences were surrendered.

3 Premises Licences were lapsed.

1 Premises Licence was time limited and has now expired.

No Club Premises Certificate were surrendered.

In summary, in October 2023 there were 1125 Premises Licences and Club Premises Licences, and in December 2023, there were 1126.
