Following discussions with Dan Kinsman ((Environmental Health Officer, East Suffolk Council) who had submitted a representation concerning the proposed application for a new premises licence for The Wood Yard, Woodbridge. The Applicant has proposed changes to the application, regarding the times for licensable activities, as well as additional conditions to be added to the licence. The proposed changes are below.

Dear Leonie

In response to your e-mail, I can confirm that I wish to change the licensable times for the sale of alcohol and films as well as the opening hours of the premises to fit with the existing planning permission.

These will be as follows:

Supply of alcohol (on & off sales) Tuesday to Saturday 9:00 to 23:00 and Sunday 9:00 to 22:00 (with last food order at 21:30 (Sunday only)

Films (indoors) 18:00 to 23:00 Tuesday to Saturday and 18:00 to 22:00 Sunday. Opening hours 9:00 to 23:00 Tuesday to Saturday and 9:00 to 22:00 Sunday.

I can confirm that the outside seating area will not be used after 22:00 and that all tables and chairs will be packed away as not to be used.

As discussed with Mr Kinsman I agree to abide by the following terms and conditions.

- 1. No noise shall emanate from the premises nor vibration be transmitted through the structure of the premises that gives rise to a nuisance at nearby noise sensitive receptor locations.
- 2. Notices will be prominently displayed at all exits requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and businesses and leave the area quietly.
- 3. The premises licence holder shall ensure that any patrons drinking and/or smoking outside the premises do so in an orderly manner and are supervised by staff so as to ensure that there is no public nuisance or obstruction of the public highway.

I hope that strongly abiding by these terms will help us come to an agreement on the licensing terms.
