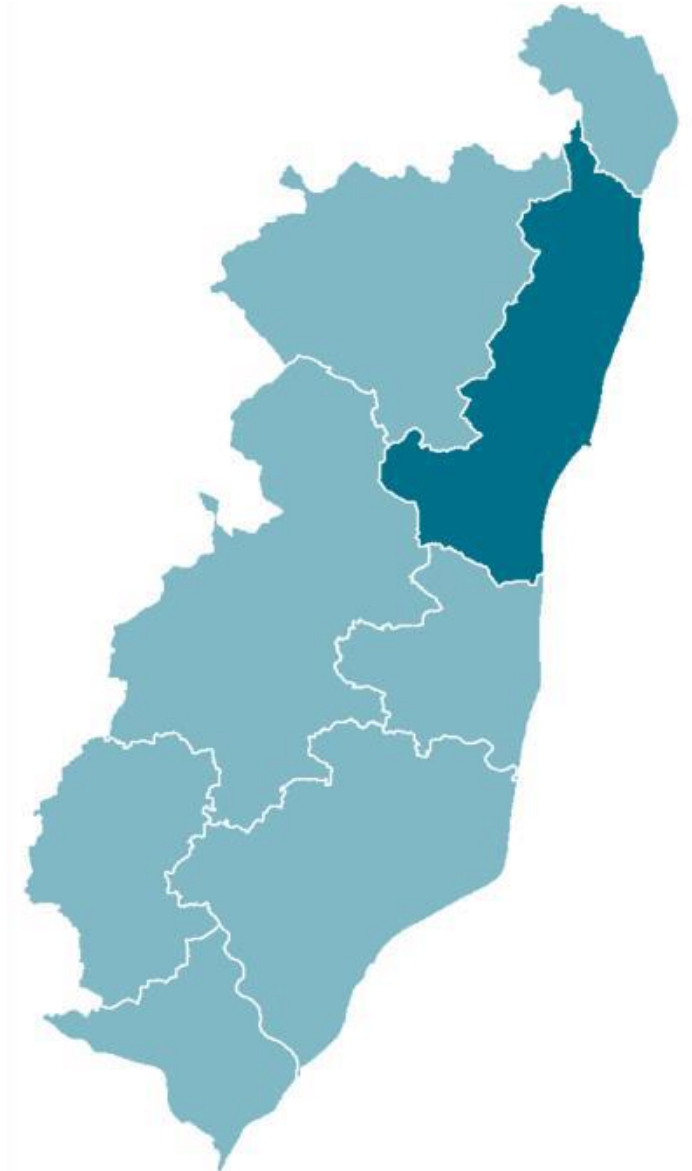


Operation Outdoors!

Improving rural facilities, environmental awareness, physical and mental wellbeing, teaching lifeskills, reducing social isolation for young people and children

Sports Equality Project

ESC led project (initially) to increase accessibility to sports and physical activity for young people post Covid. Building resilience and confidence, improving physical and mental wellbeing. Tackling financial barriers to inclusion.

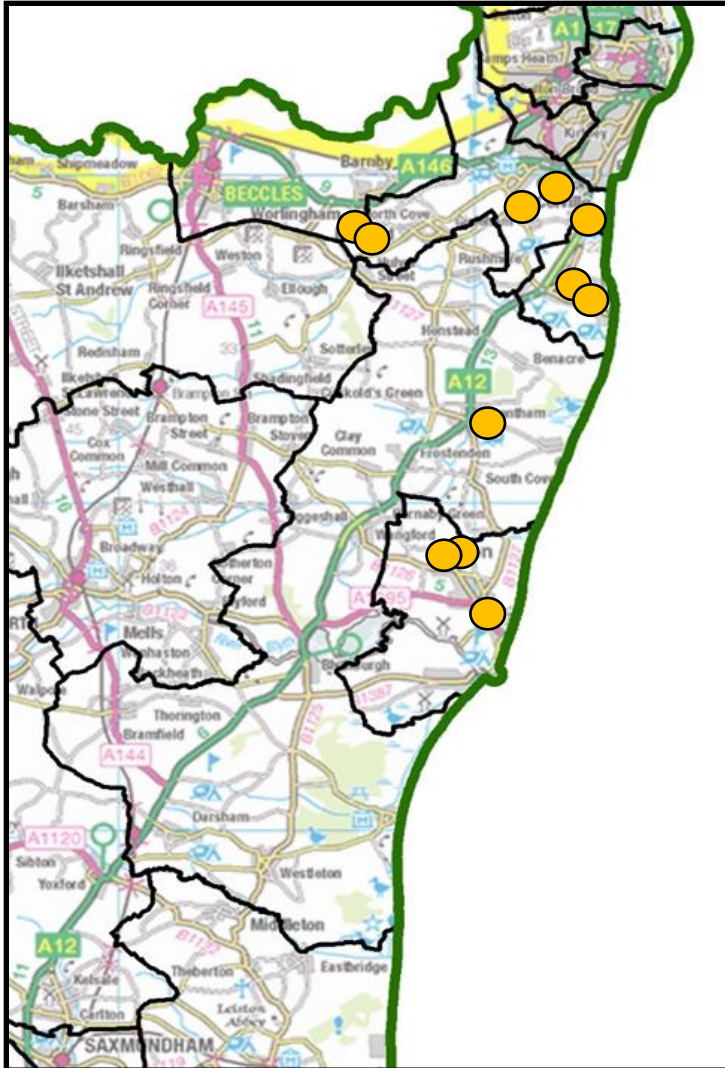
Achievements - Small Grants

Small grants = big impact!

11 grants awarded with a total of £13,056.

Grants awarded across the CP area and benefit a wide demographic

All projects address either priority 2 (Reduce social isolation and loneliness) or priority 3 (facilities, activities and employment for young people).



Projects include:

- Activities for adults with additional needs
- Enhancing facilities in rural communities.
- Improvement of park/green spaces
- Environmental/nature engagement.
- Enhancing community group facilities to allow for expanded reach.

Post Covid Reset

- Assess new data pack (and census if available) before July CP meeting
- Expand membership of CP both core and ad hoc.
- Encourage in person attendance.
- Review and agree priorities at July CP meeting
- Review processes - SMART objectives, strategic commissioning, monitoring and proving impact.
