Aims of Task and Finish Group:

Need to resurrect Task and Finish Groups to ensure that wider spread of projects are applying for the funding available, and to develop grass root engagement.

Funding is available until 1st of June via Woodbridge, Melton and Deben Peninsula Community Partnership Area Small Grant Scheme to meet the priorities of:

- Developing Opportunities for Young People £15,000
- Improving Community Hubs £15,000

Small Grant Scheme 2021:

Need to look at projects to fit into Small Grant Scheme

Developing Opportunities for Young People:

- Grants to fall between values of £250 - £2500
- No second year funding for same projects
- Only one application so far from Hollesley
- Projects offering activities for young people would be specifically considered
- Would also be useful to target specific areas of ASB
- ACT could replicate a Detached Youth Work Project
- ACT Pink/Orange Scheme could be replicated
- 1st Woodbridge Scouts could be an opportunity
- Friends of Woodbridge Library – could look at applying

Community Hubs:

- Grants to fall between values of £250 - £2500
- It would be useful to have more projects to improve inclusiveness of village hubs
- Hollesley – holistic wellbeing centre opportunity – could some funding be offered towards improving services
- Health concerns – Wooden Fitness Equipment/recreation field improvements
- Community Hub funds could be used to develop out of hall services eg virtual projects/trips for resident groups etc
- Bus Shelter – could look at applying

Actions:

- Request for group to disseminate application form and guidance for application
