Project name:

Summer Activities Programme for Beccles, Bungay and Halesworth

Project summary:

Delivery of open access Free school summer holiday activities for young people (9-16 years) across the three market towns but also open to young people from surrounding villages.

Costings breakdown:

Amount requested - £1,500 (£500 per market Town)

An approximate cost for each Market Town would be £1,250 - £1,275. This is for one session per week in each town for 5 weeks. This includes 3 coaches to deliver a session and purchase of equipment. This works out at £250 per session based on £1,250.

Additional match funding will be required but we are confident this can be sourced from either Town Councils, East Suffolk Council's Enabling Budgets or Suffolk County Council Locality Budgets.

How this project will address the Community Partnership priority:

Offering a diverse range of physical activities, not just sporting, for young people during the holiday period and chance to engage with other young people with opportunities to meet new friends, try new activities whilst being outside. Advice and support provided, possibly through Onelife Suffolk, on healthy living.

Possibility of linking with other known activity providers in the areas to offer alternative activities, such as water sports for part of the project.

Location and land ownership:

tbc but will be in the three market towns at known locations determined by engaging with Town/Parish Councils and other service providers. Where possible, this could be rotated across parks/open spaces in a particular town rather than delivering in the same location each week.

Accountable body:

Catch 22/Positive Future or Go Geronimo. Depending on the market town. For example, Go Geronimo already deliver summer activities in Halesworth.

Time scale (approx.) for delivery:

July and August (school summer holidays)

Partner groups involved:

Catch 22/Positive Futures, G0 Geronimo, Town/Parish Councils, Police, East Suffolk Communities Team.
