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'Get your 5G mast off my land at once'

Homeowner blockades grass verge in row



A Kirkley man has blockaded workmen from installing a mobile phone mast in a row over land rights.

Michael Garman, 69, leapt into action to prevent the mast being put on a patch of land outside his house on the corner of Carlton Road and Kirkley Park Road that he says he owns.

On Tuesday, Mr Garman first sat on a deckchair and later parked his car and mobile home

In March, East Suffolk Council gave permission to Signal Infrastructure Limited to install a 15m mast on the site to provide 3G, 4G and 5G to the area.
