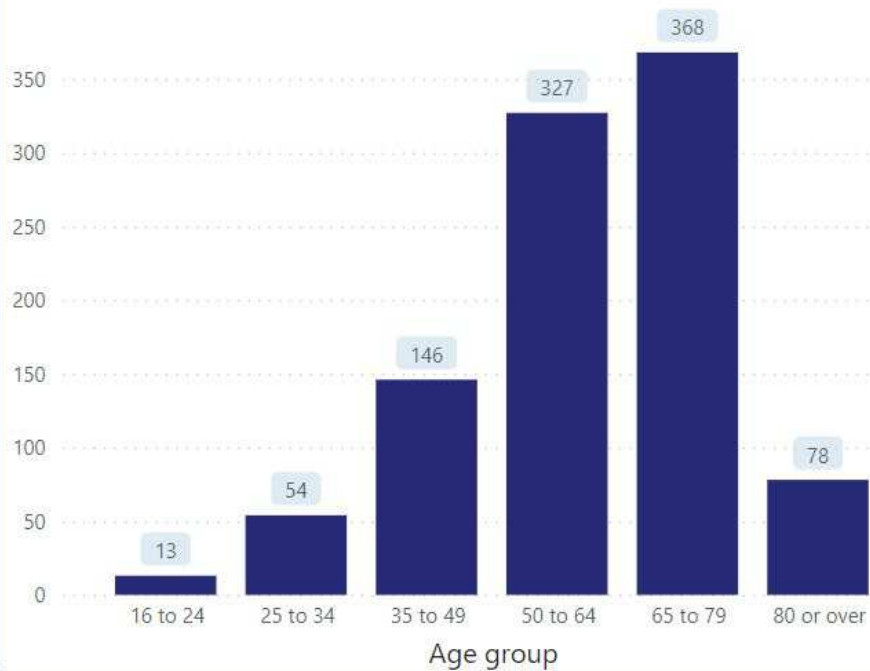

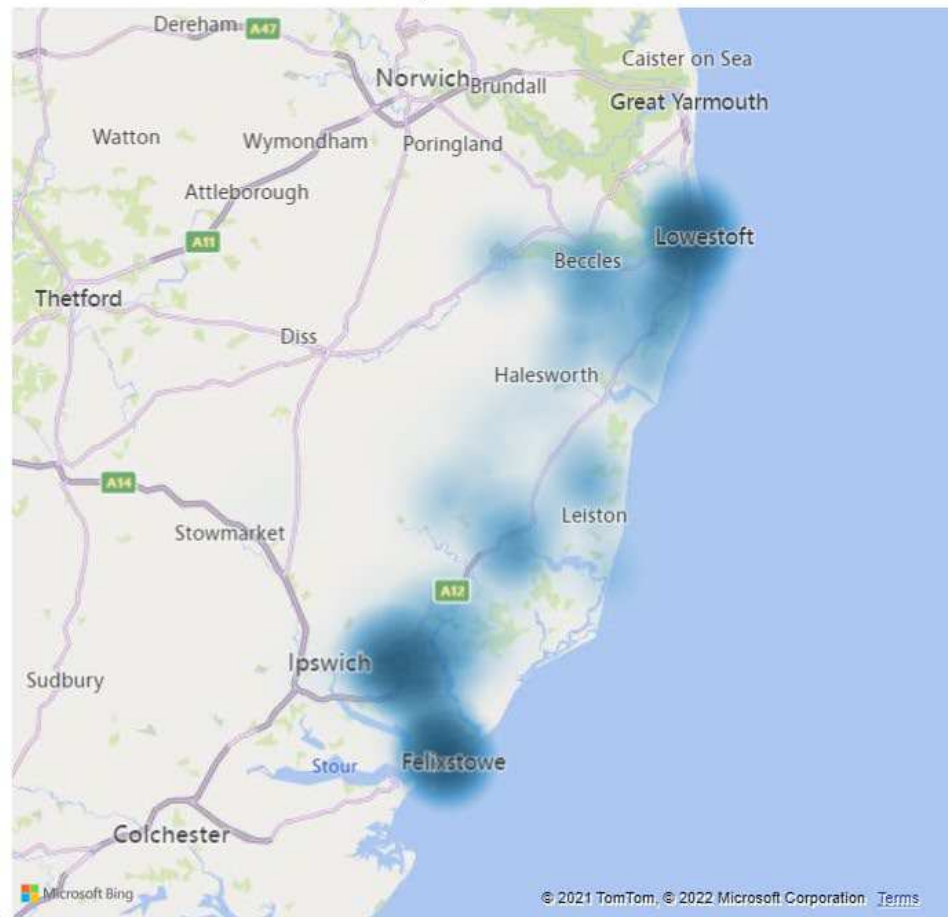

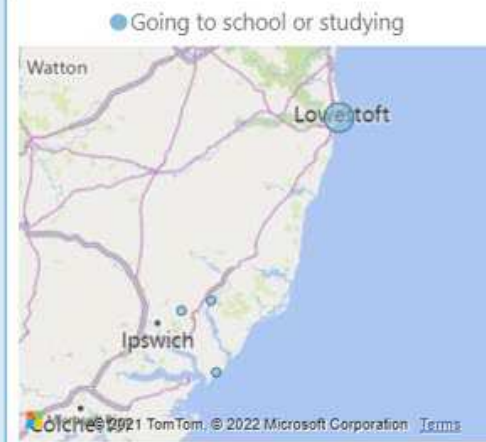
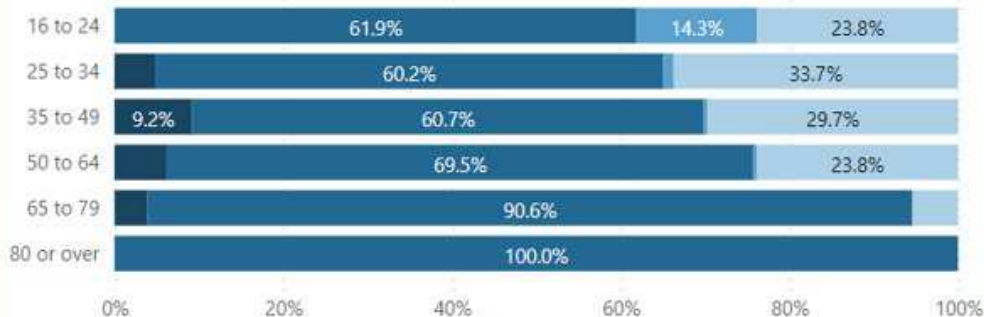

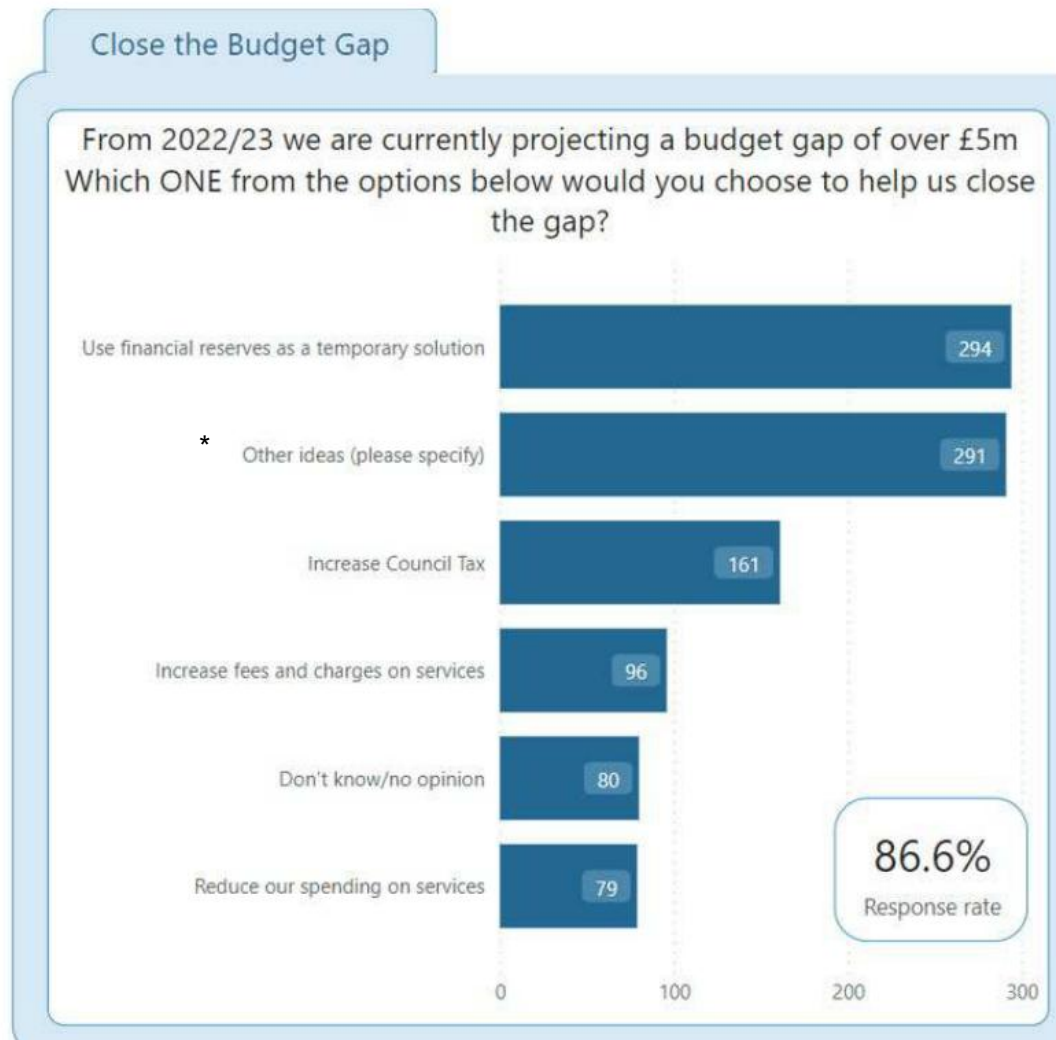

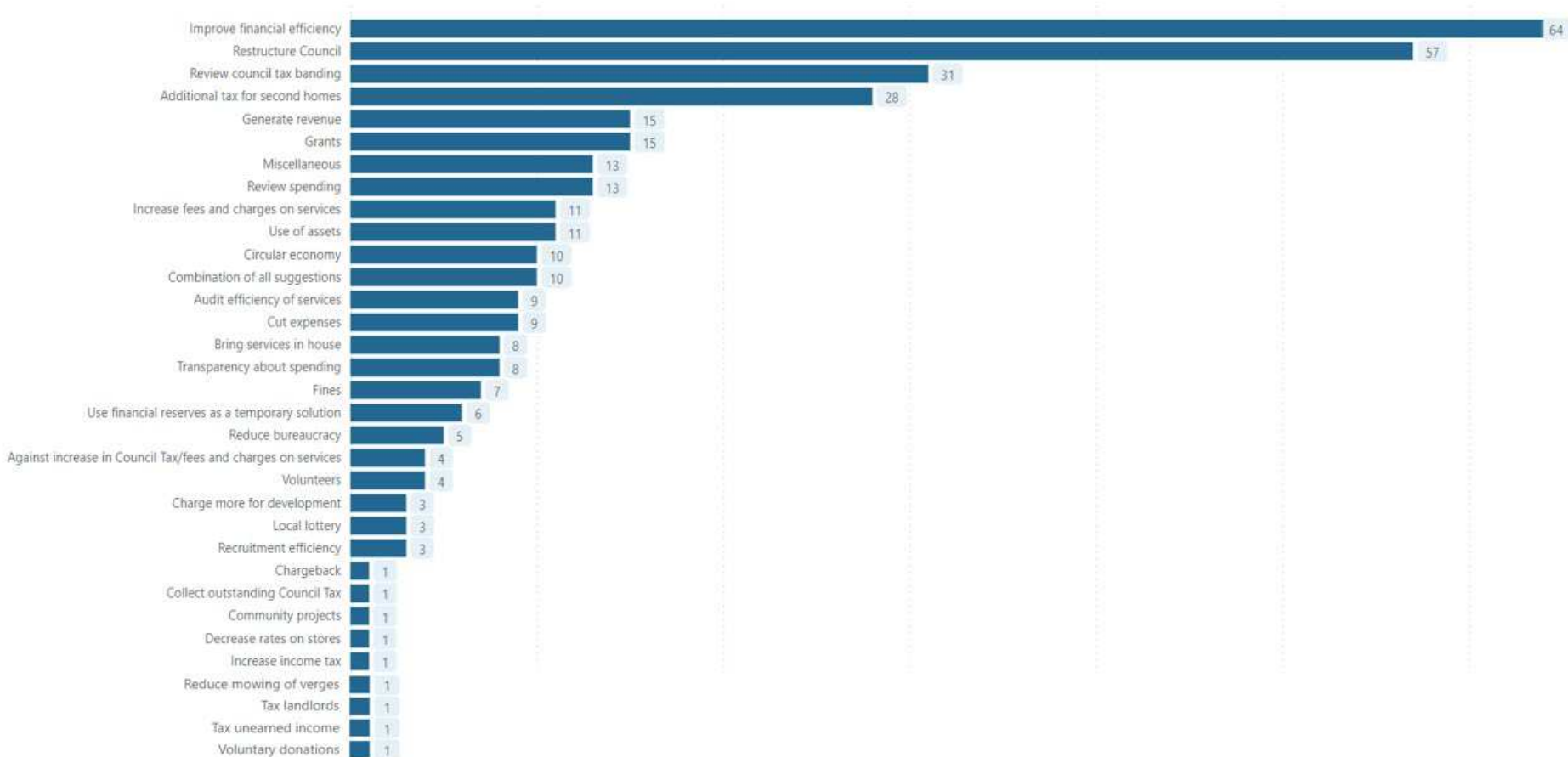

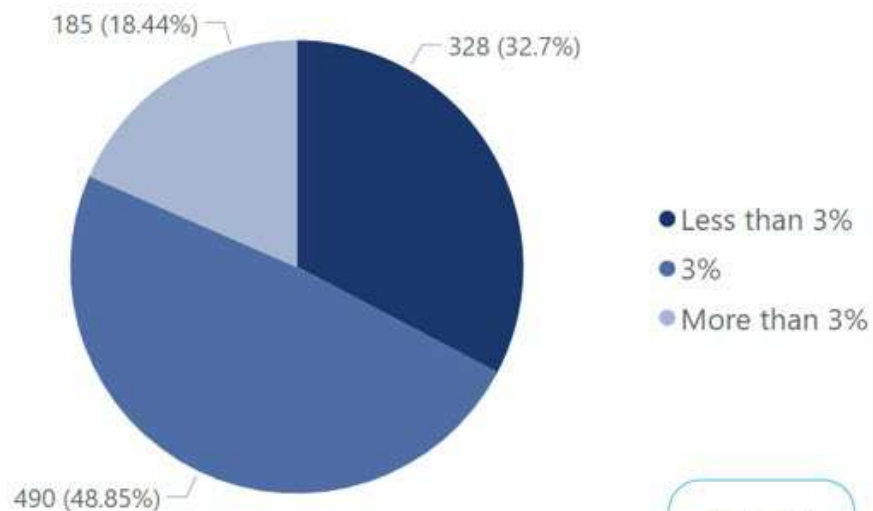

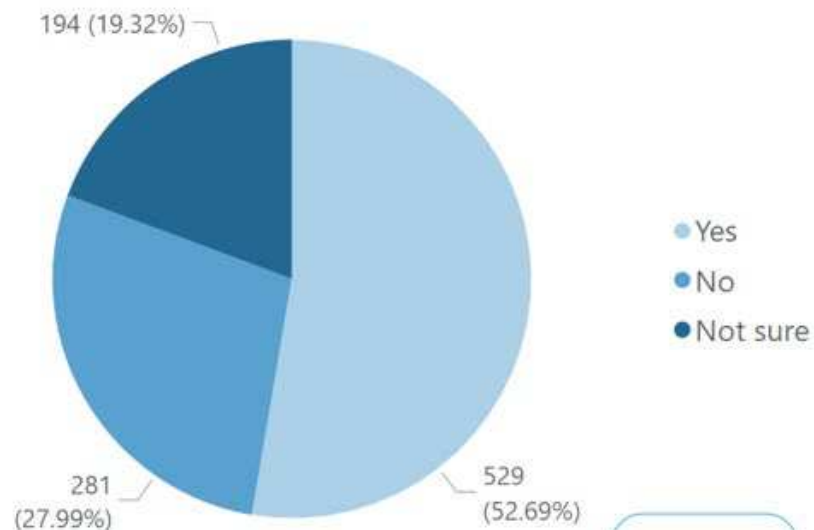
Council Tax and Carbon Neutral 2030

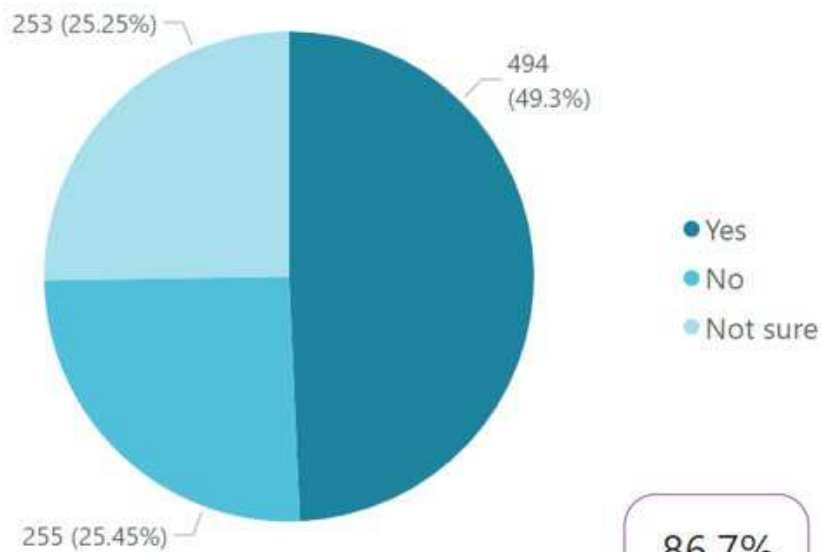

Investing in land and buildings

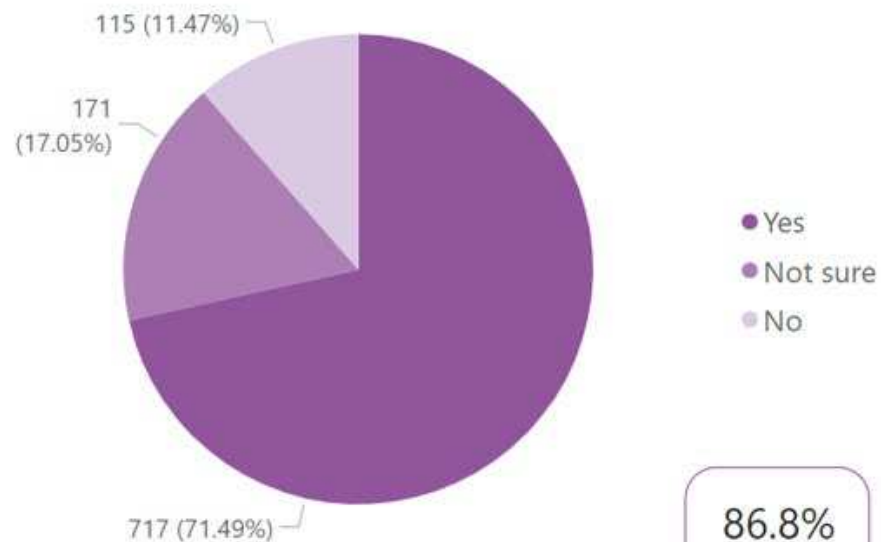
Do you agree with the principle of us investing in land and buildings in the district to generate income for the council?
