General underpinning priority and consideration:

Developing active and sustainable transport solutions and/or community transport

Tackling

Tackling social isolation and loneliness for all ages including young people

Improving

Improving physical and mental health and wellbeing, enabling people to live healthy and encouraging physical activity including cycling and walking

Where we are at and what we've achieved

- We now have a 17 year old young person on our Community Partnership
- We held a refresher session for parishes in April 2022 and a well received Community Partnership showcase in May 2022
- Our CP first started looking at cost of living in September 2021 and have tried to embed this in projects like oral health packs & slipper swap
- Some projects piloted in our CP area have been picked up as part of the Ease the Squeeze programme including Warm Rooms and Comfort Food (building on the success of Thin Ice in Lowestoft)
- Exciting youth research project currently underway in Halesworth and surrounding villages
- Some parishes previously not as engaged have attended CP meetings and been engaging more
- All three of our Volunteer Centres now have a permanent place at the Community Partnership
- Links developed with local supermarkets to support CP initiatives and to link groups with their funding pots

AREAS OF INNOVATION AND EXAMPLES

Oral health packs

"The pupils were excited to clean their teeth with their very own toothpaste. The were shocked with how long they should clean their teeth for but loved having a timer to help them."

Feedback from a primary school

Funded 600 oral health packs to be provided to 11 year olds to promote good oral hygiene

Each pack has a toothbrush, toothpaste tube, timer and information sheet

Working in partnership with Community Dental Services

These have been distributed in local primary schools (around 350), scout groups and food banks

They have been well received by schools and children

43% of young people surveyed said they had made changes to looking after their teeth

40% of those surveyed are brushing longer than before they received the packs

• 60 pairs of slippers bought to be provided to older people

Why?

 To help prevent falls in the home and to provide a gateway to additional support

Impact

- Well received thus far from recipients, families, partner organisations (foot practitioners) and groups from further afield!
- Referrals continuing to flow in
- One referral has since been supported financially from a local fund as a result of the initial contact
